MILESTONES

KITS is established in the year 2008 with the noble vision of its founders, strongly believes in the concept of holistic education and strives to achieve its goal of preparing students to meet the challenges that we face in the twenty-first century. There are **8 UG** Programmes with sanction intake of **1020**, and **4 PG** Programmes with sanction intakes of **72**. Five UG (CE, EEE, ME, ECE, and CSE) programmes are accredited by NBA, New Delhi. The institution is accredited by NAAC with **A Grade** in the year **2017** and got extended up to **2025**. JNTUK Provided permanent affiliation. Since, 2020 KITS college functions as an autonomous institution.

STATE-OF-THE-INFRASTRUCTURE:

The class rooms are well designed with perfect ventilation and good acoustic condition, additionally, air conditioned.All department laboratories are well equipped with latest equipment's, and are updated to provide training as needed by the industries.There are 3 seminar halls with various capacity (approximately 600 members, 250 members, and 200 members). There is a dedicated **Training and Placement Cell.** It comprises 11 panel rooms, 1 board room.

The library is well accommodated with 34306 volumes and 6167 titles available to meet the requirements of the students. A huge provision of 75 national, international print journals and a big number of E-Journals is made to enable the students to acquire the knowledge of latest trends. The digital library provides the students with e-resources offered by J-GATE, INFLIBNET, NLIST, DELNET. We hold membership in the National Digital Library of India.

IMPORTANT ORGANIZATIONS

Our college is proud of some distinguished cells where the students take the prominent lead bringing laurels to the institute with their many remarkable achievements.

NSS:

The National Social Service Unit of our institute is taking up highly appreciable programmes and projects for the benefit of the society. As a part of its activities, the volunteers visited many orphanages, old-age homes and contributed to those societies. During the pandemic time of Covid-19, the unit organized vaccination camps on campus and succeeded in vaccinating the 100% students and staff members. Besides health checkup camps the unit is also conducting health awareness rallies in the region. The unit raised funds and helped the needy during the periods of lockdown.

<u>NCC</u>

I am very happy to inform you that the 10 Andhra Girls Battalion (Sr.Wing) is functioning in a commendable way. Adequate accommodation and training are being offered to the cadets. Our cadets are leading several rallies to promote social awareness and crowning the glory of the institute. The intake is strengthened with **52** cadets during **2020-2021**. So far **65 cadets** have got B-Certificate while **27 got C-Certificate**.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP CELL

To promote the spirit of Entrepreneurship among students on our campus, we initiated the cell and encouraged students to start their own enterprises. We are inviting the trailblazers and arranging their interaction with the students helping them to get engaged in many startups.

LANGUAGE CLUBS

To make students aware of the importance of English and to create an English-speaking environment in college campuses, English Language Clubs are introduced. They provide a platform to students for the development of their communication skills and enhance students' English knowledge. The clubs like LEAD, SELF, JEEVAN KOUSHAL benefit the students to master their English skill. The members of the club take part in various competitions and impart their knowledge to their peers.

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

The research forum of KITS college of Technology has been actively involved in promoting innovation and research activities.

The department of ECE and CSE have been recognized as research center by JNTUK, Kakinada. Two scholars pursuing their PhD., through our research center.

The faculty members are consistently involved in the research activities and published papers in reputed SCI, Scopus indexed journals. Our faculty have published six patents during post COVID.

INSTITUTIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS:

The Institution Innovation Cell(**IIC**) along with the commendable placements, pave the way for innovations, industry interactions to drive the students towards success with avenues of funding and investment opportunities. The outcomes of the IIC are:

- 1. A batch of students has received a fund assistance of Rs. 13 Lakh from MSME, Govt. of India to develop their prototype for chili farmers.
- 2. A batch of students has received Rs. 10Lakh to develop Eye deep in healthcare and biomedical devices.

3. A batch of students has received Rs.25Lakh to design a Robo forming devices

Additionally, the cell is selected as a Mentor institution and under the scheme Mentor- Mentee programme 2021-2022. This academic yearKITS comes under Top 100 T-Schools (overall government and private sector) by Data Quest-CMR Best T-School Survey 2022. In the Annual campus partner Meet-2022, a certificate of appreciation to KITS college is provided by HCL for top achiever's award. **Rs. 54, 10, 500**/-has been received from various funding agency such as AICTE, SERB/DST, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, and Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME).

Having felt the need to strengthen the industry-institution interaction and collaboration, our college has signed **MoUs** with some major industries and organizations as per the AICTE guidelines. These areEFFTRONICS, AGIIT, LabTech Pvt Ltd., SVR Electricals, ETI Labs Pvt Ltd., CPLR, and TALENTIO ACADEMY, BLACK BUCKS, EDU SKILLS, MAD BLOCKS, etc., respectively.

INSTITUTIONAL PLACEMENT RECORD:

This year we have a good placement record. A considerable number of campus drives are held. Many prominent companies have recruited 502 job seekers with multiple offers put together to 919. Here are the details:

- 153 Job Seekers of Department of CSE got 405 offers from various MNC's.
- 156 Job Seekers of Department of ECE got 263 offers from various MNC's.
- 96 Job Seekers of Department of ME got 117 offers from various MNC's.
- 53 Job Seekers of Department of EEE got 72 offers from various MNC's.
- 44 Job Seekers of Department of CE got 62 offers from various MNC's.

Many of the job seekers have got attractive CTC. Where 2 of them got package of more than 10 Lacs/A, 132 of them got between 5 and 10 Lacs, 679 of

them got wit minimum of **3 Lacs and below 5 Lacs**, and remaining **106** of them got minimum of **1.5 Lacs and below 3 Lacs**.

I am very happy to state that one student got recruited by **BNY MELLON** (**BANK OF NEWYORK**)with CTC of **17.34Lacs/A**. Whereas, **BOOK MY SHOW** has recruited another student wit CTC of **12 Lacs/A**.
