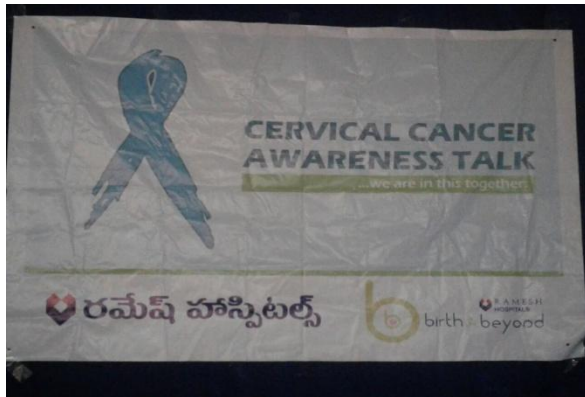

Event Description:

An Awareness Program on “Cervical Cancer” is conducted for all III&IV (Women) students of CSE department. Dr.A. Priya Nandana has explained about cervical cancer as follows:

Cervical cancer is a cancer arising from the cervix. It is due to the abnormal growth of cells that have the ability to invade or spread to other parts of the body. Early on, typically no symptoms are seen. Later symptoms may include abnormal vaginal bleeding, pelvic pain, or pain during sexual intercourse. While bleeding after sex may not be serious, it may also indicate the presence of cervical cancer. Human papillomavirus (HPV) infection causes more than 90% of cases; most people who have had HPV infections, however, do not develop cervical cancer.



She also explained about the process and cost for cervical cancer vaccination. After the talk, there was a brain storming discussion session among the students and faculties with Dr.A. Priya Nandana.
