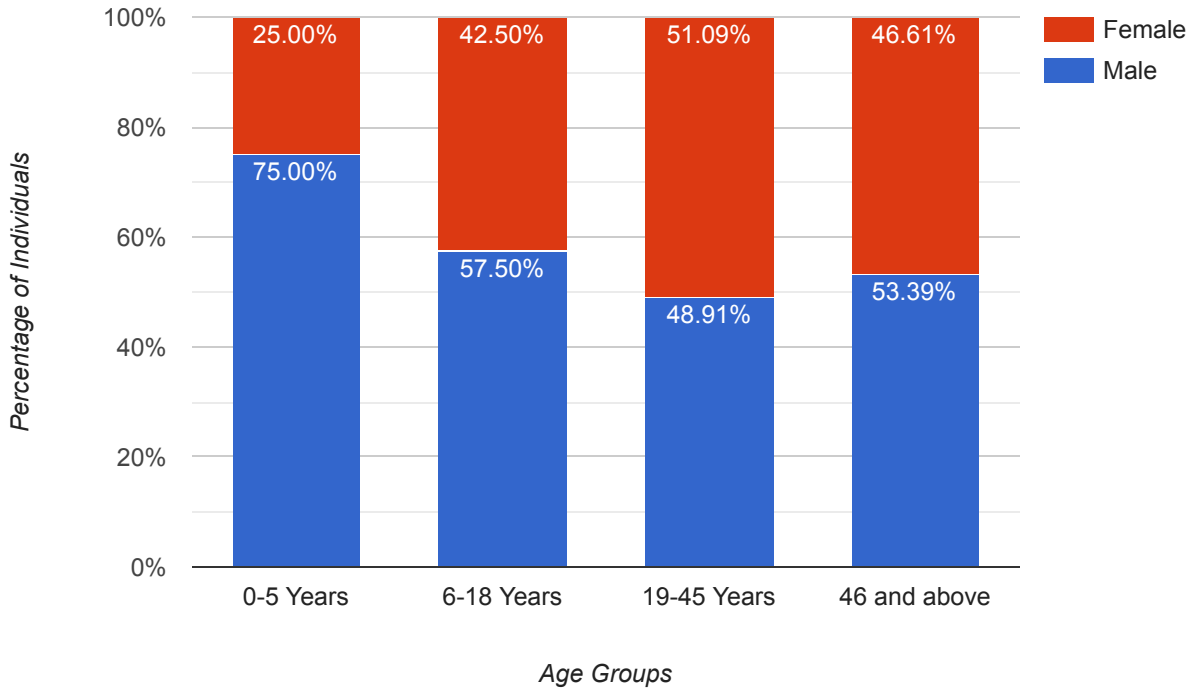

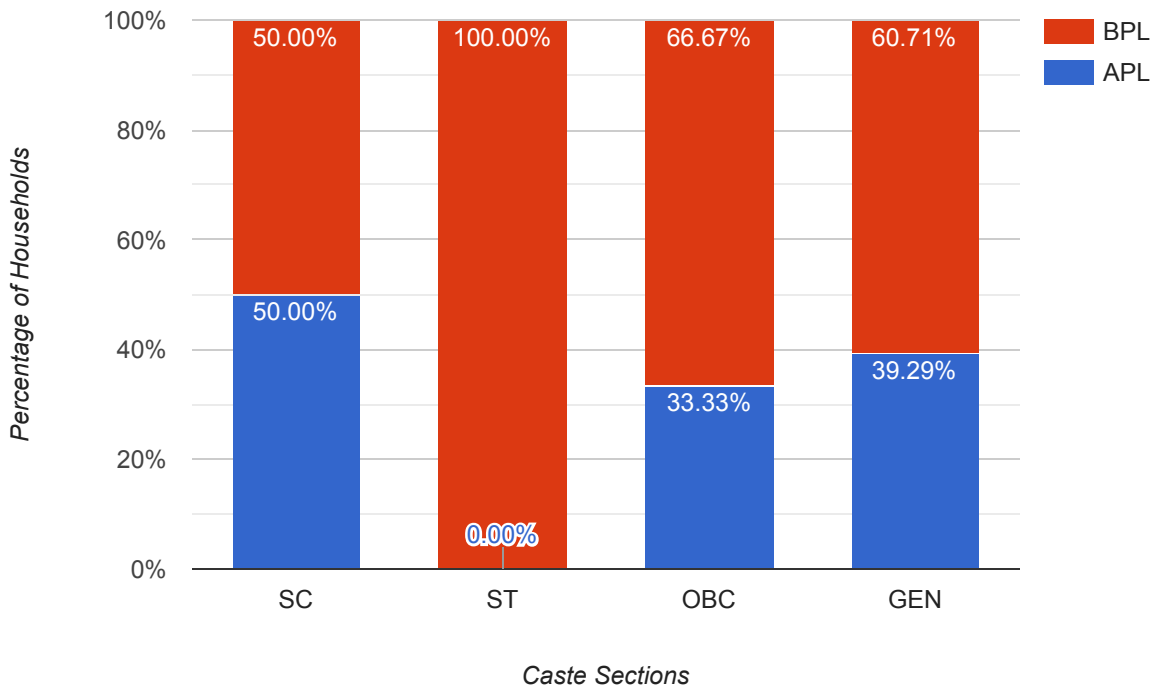

**Gender Wise Population Across Age Groups**



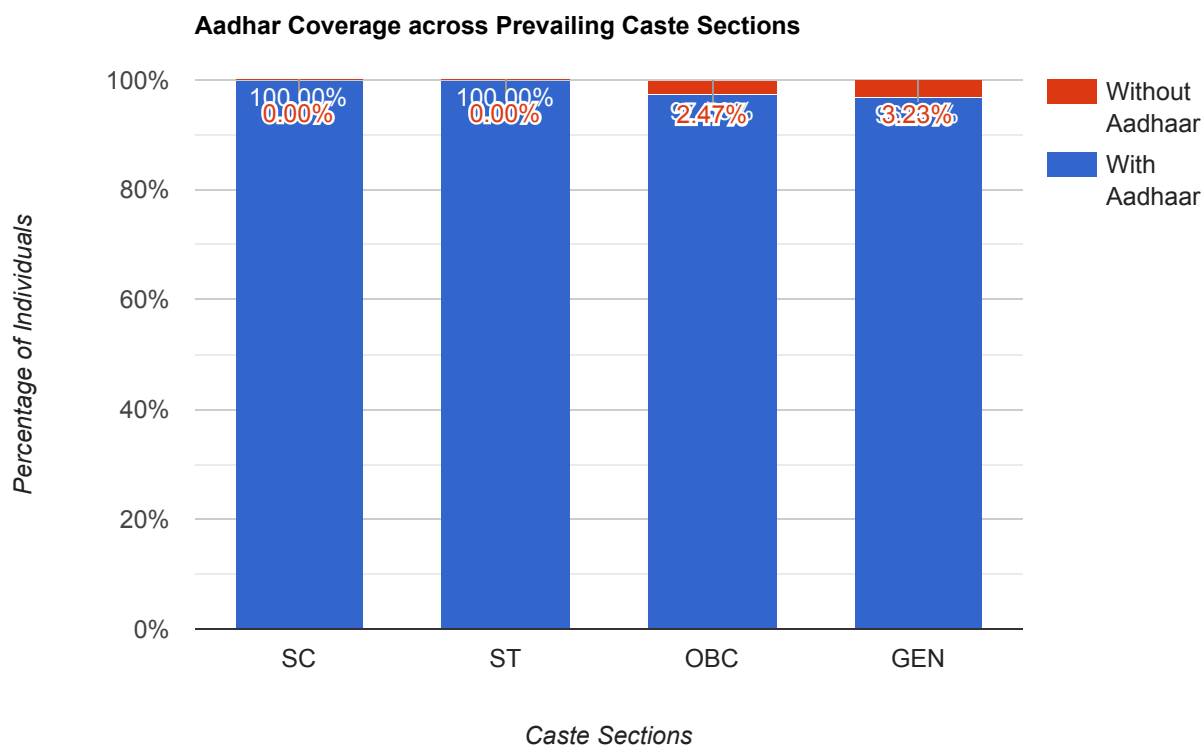
**Poverty Line across prevailing caste sections**

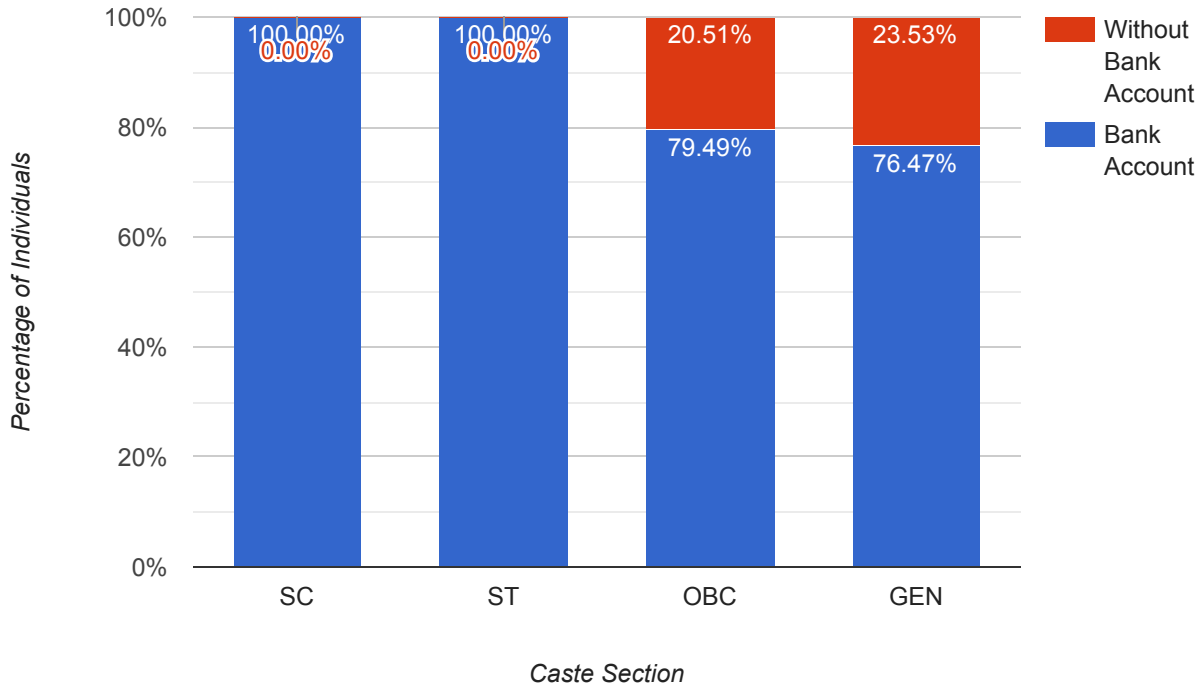

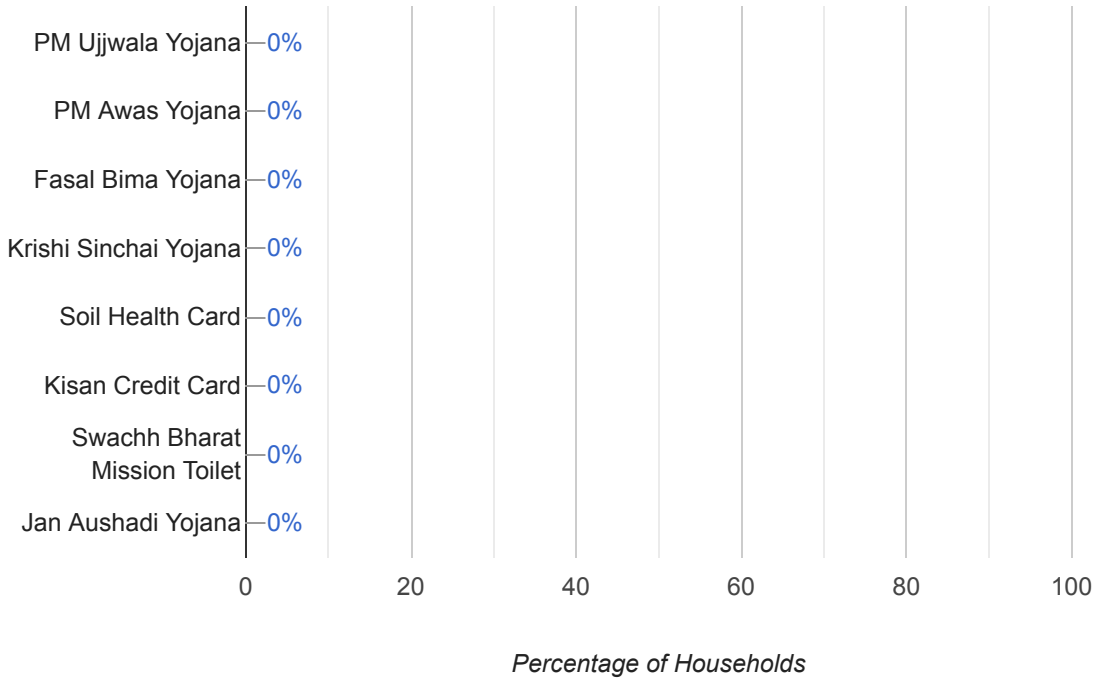

### Bank Coverage across Prevailing Caste Section



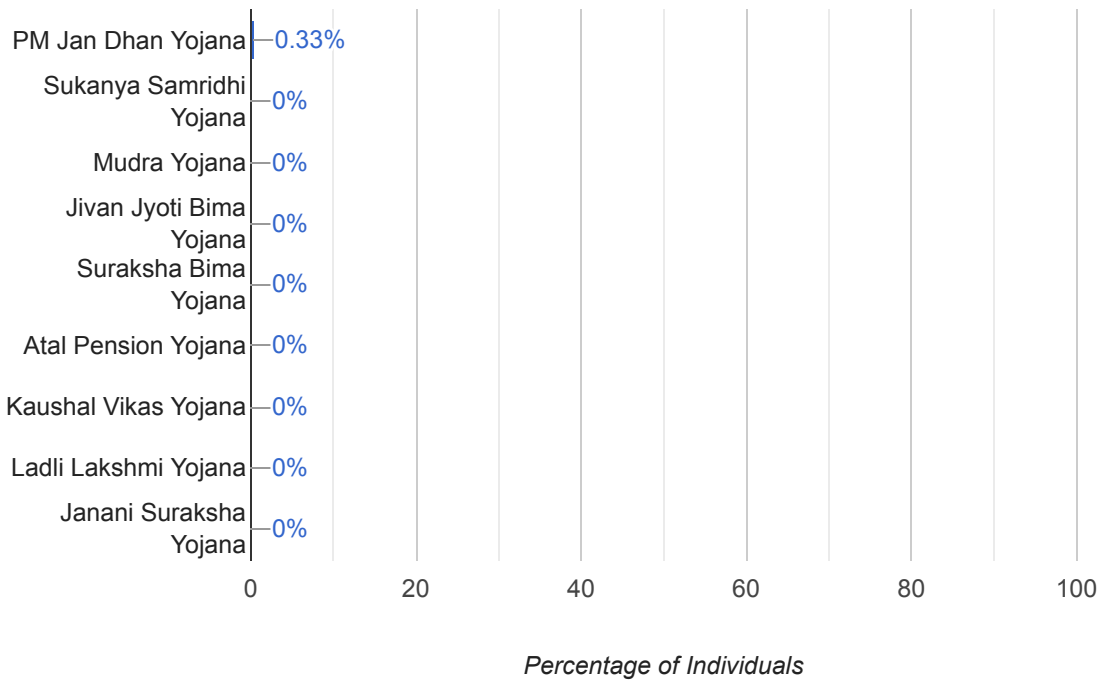

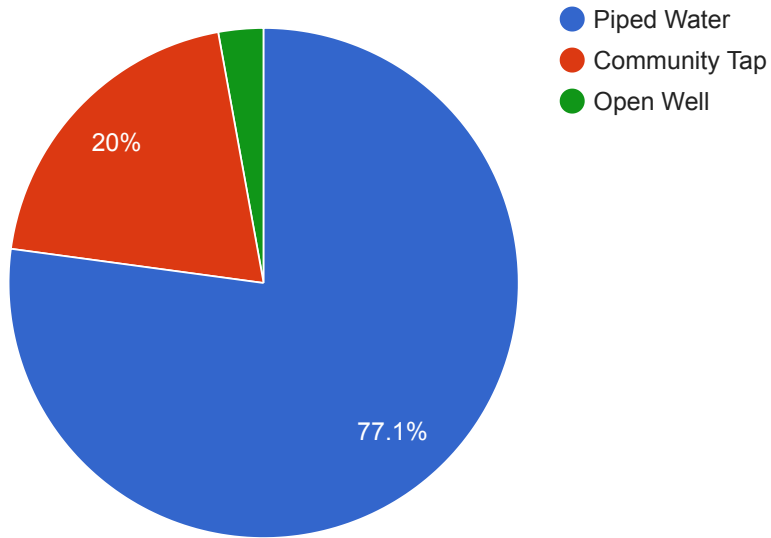

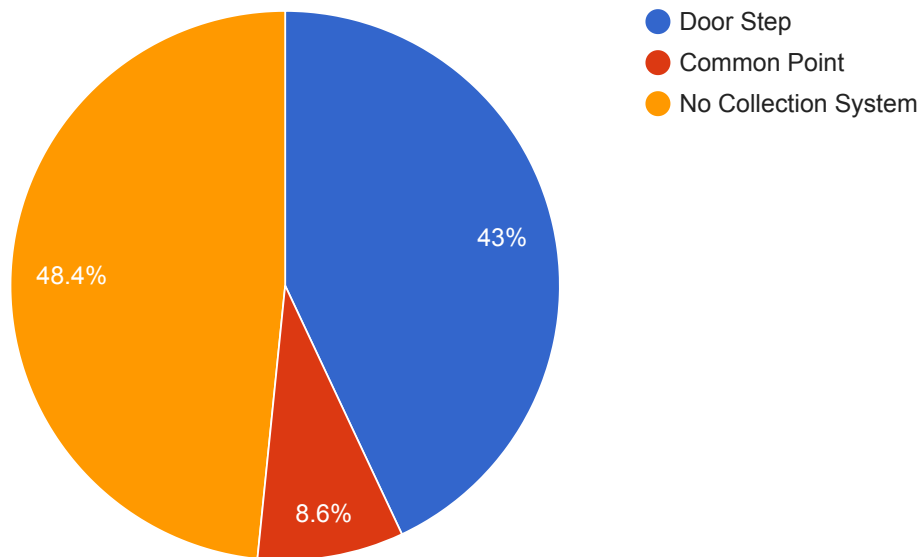

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### Household Waste Collection System

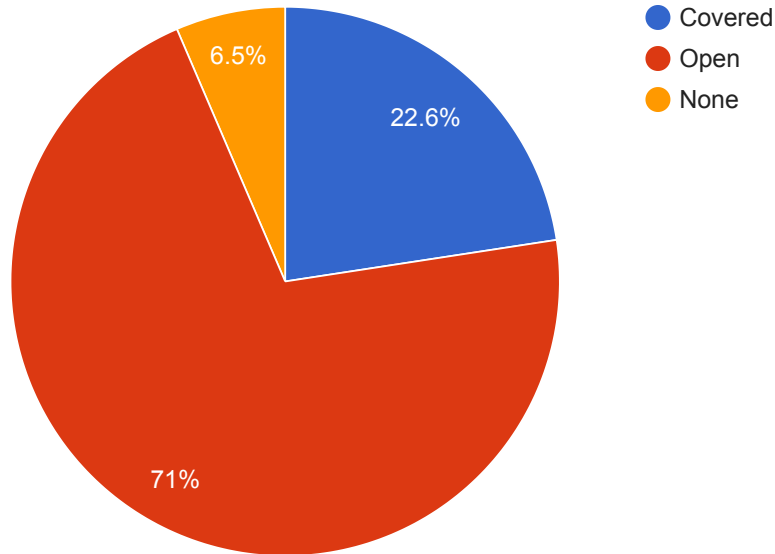

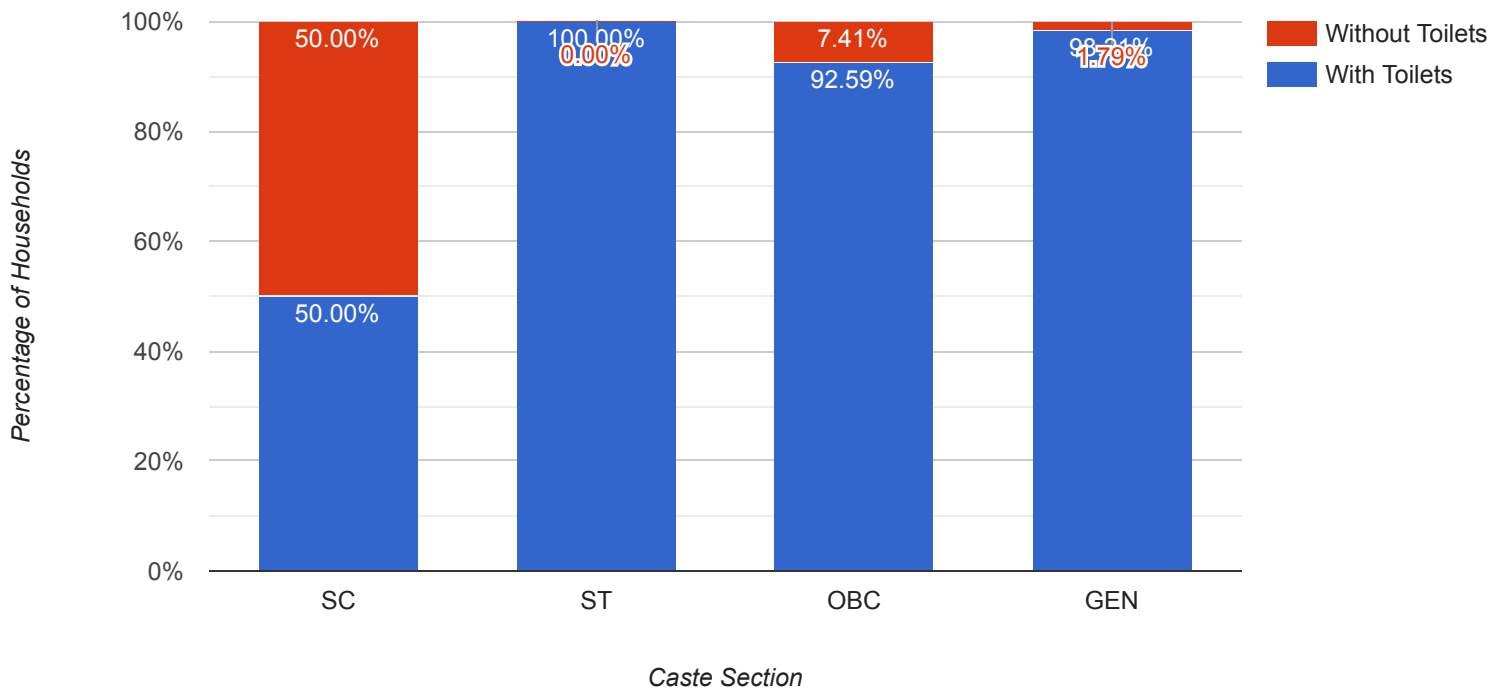

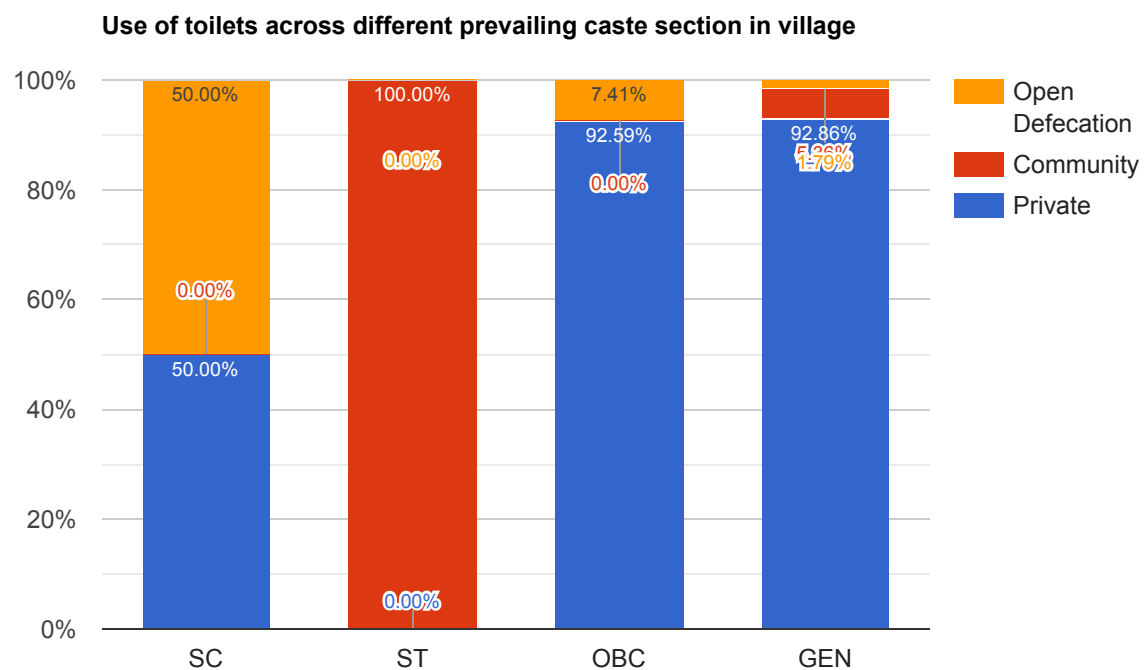
### Households with and without toilets across different prevailing caste section in village

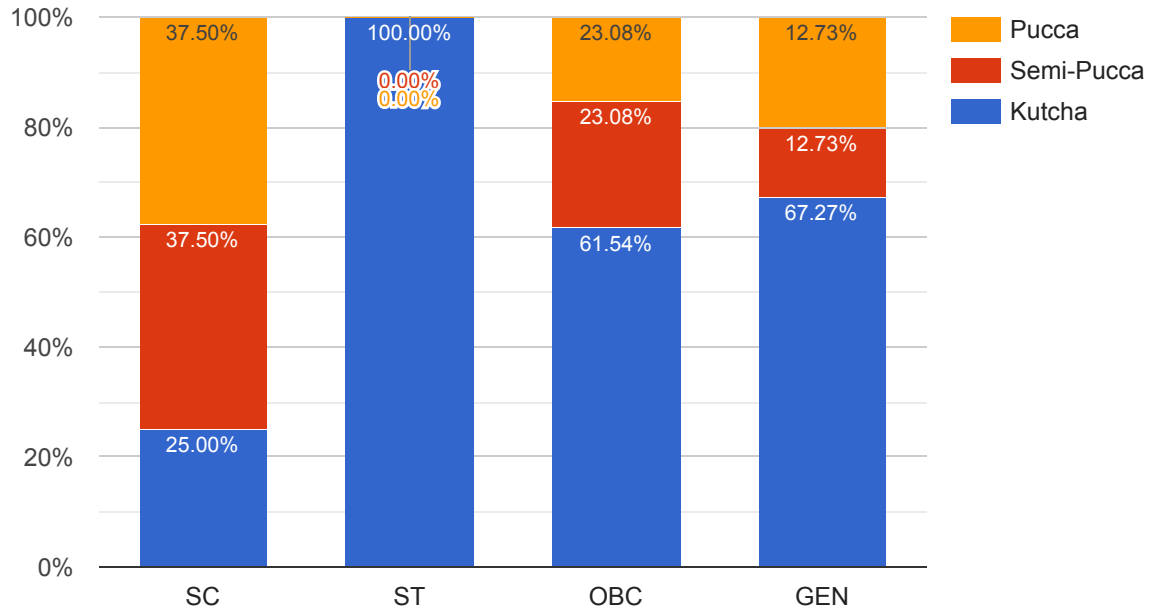

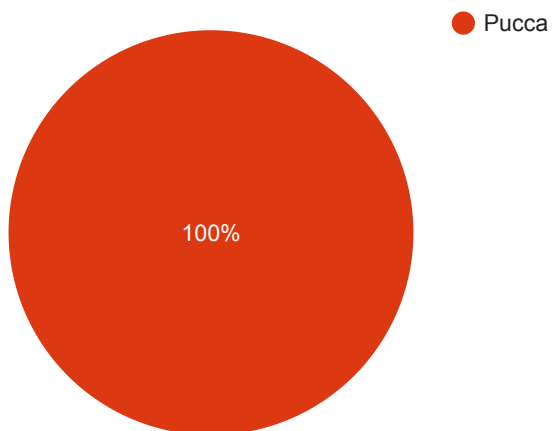

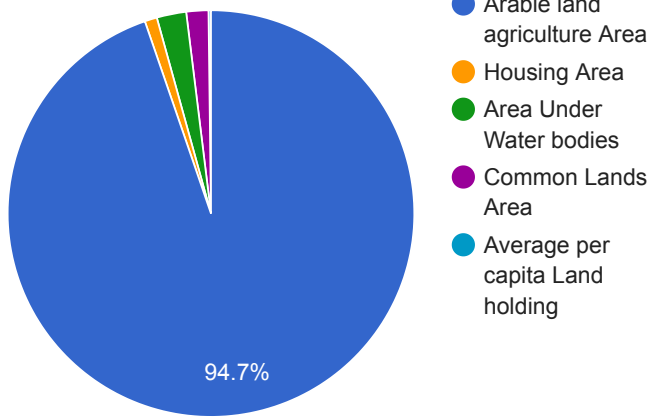

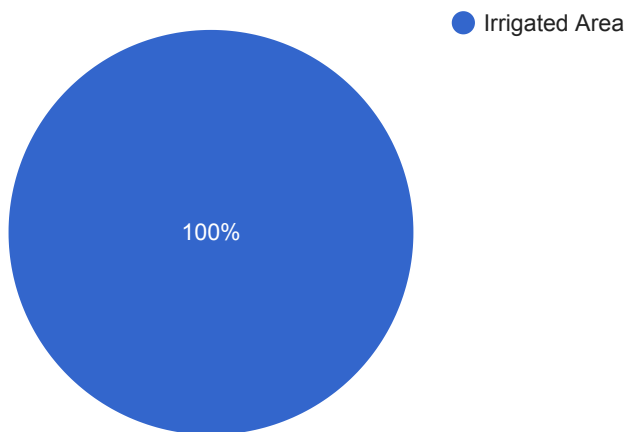

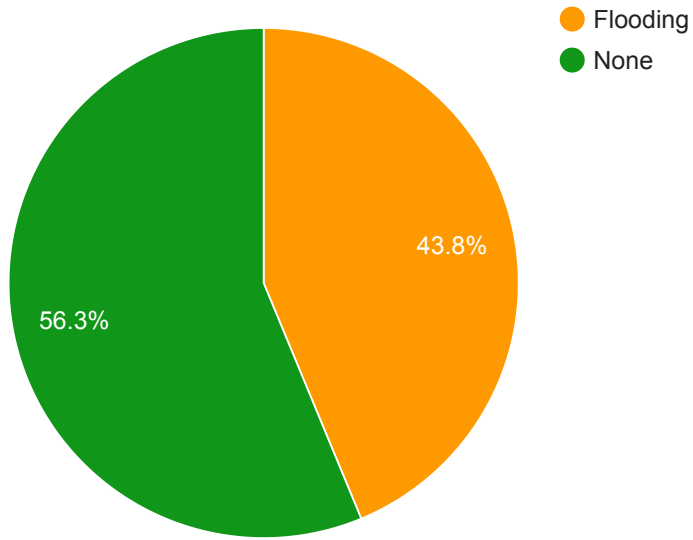

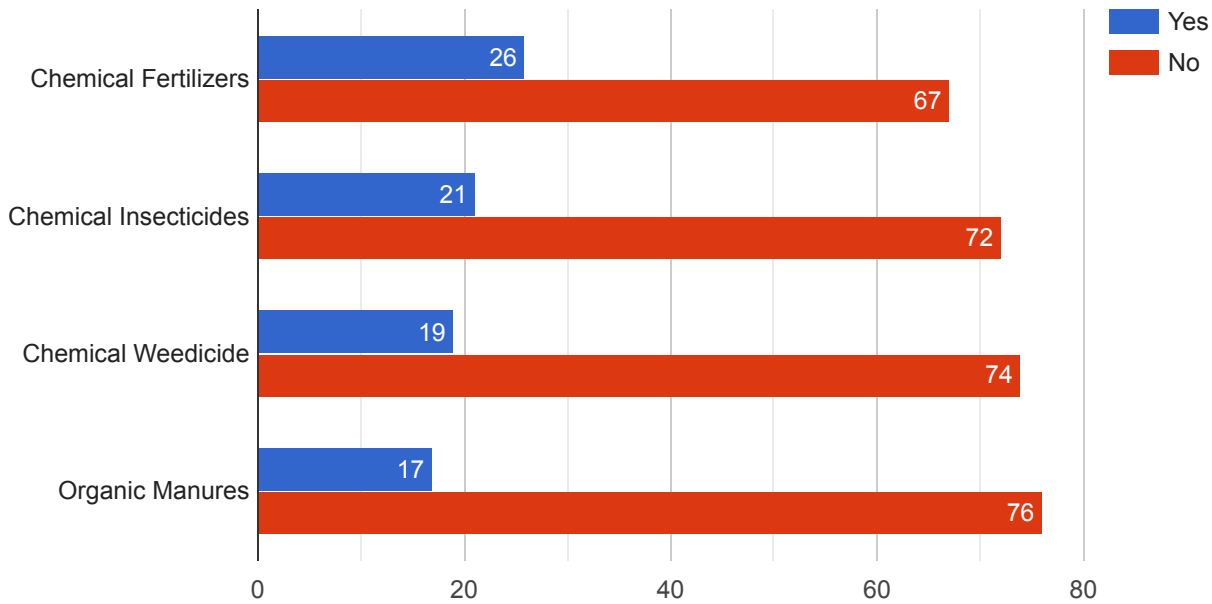

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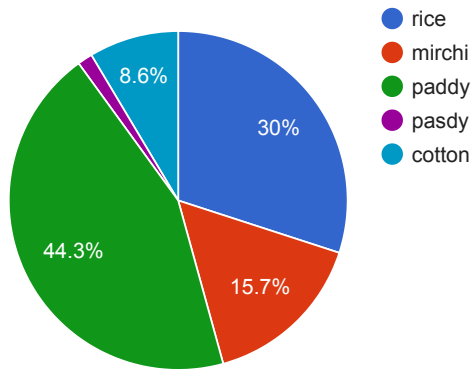

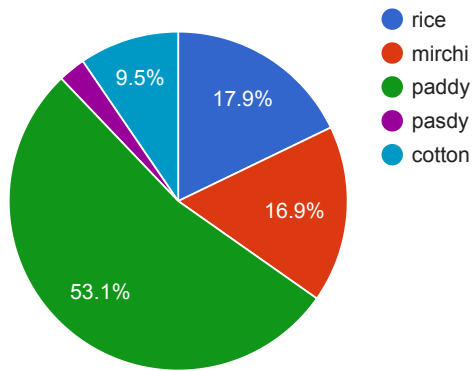

**Average Productivity per acre(in quintals) of major crops**

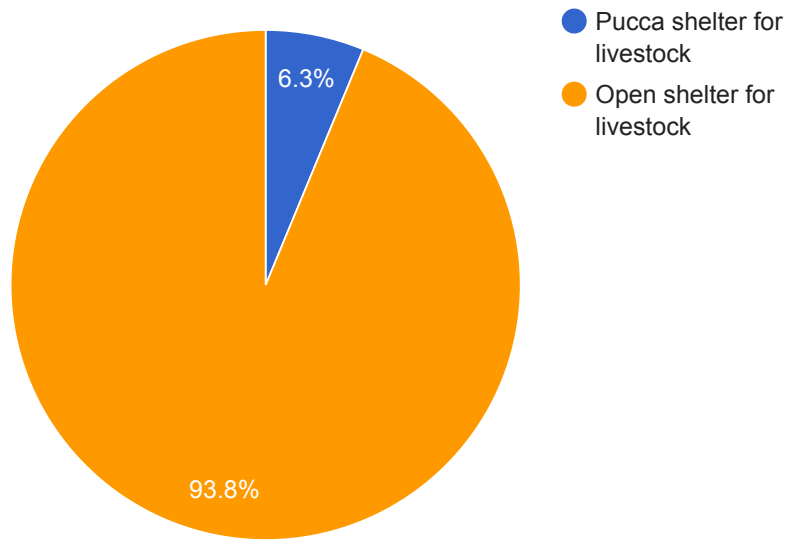

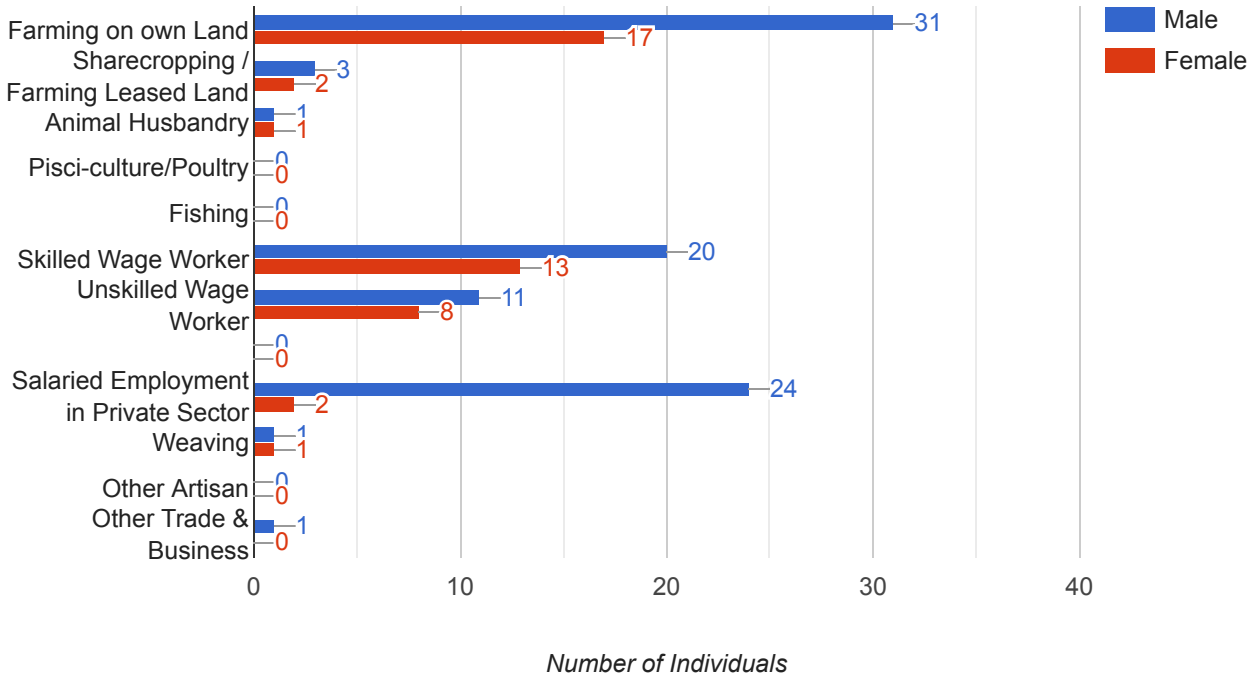

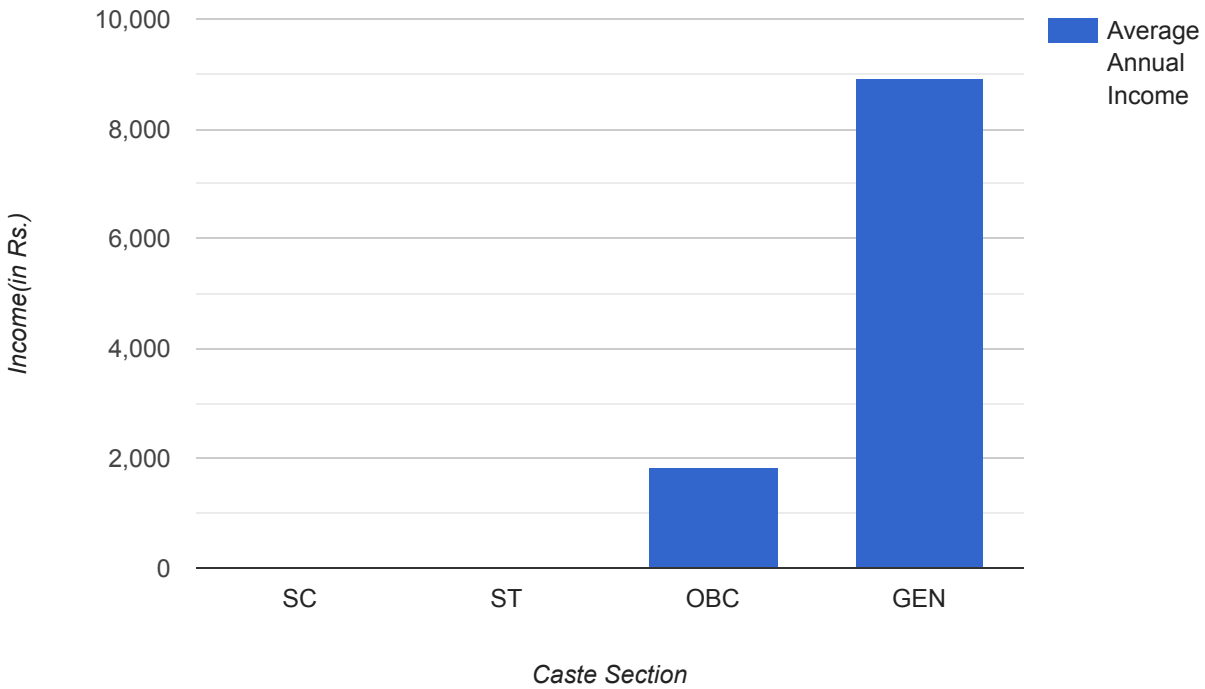
### Occupation Pattern



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### Average Annual Income



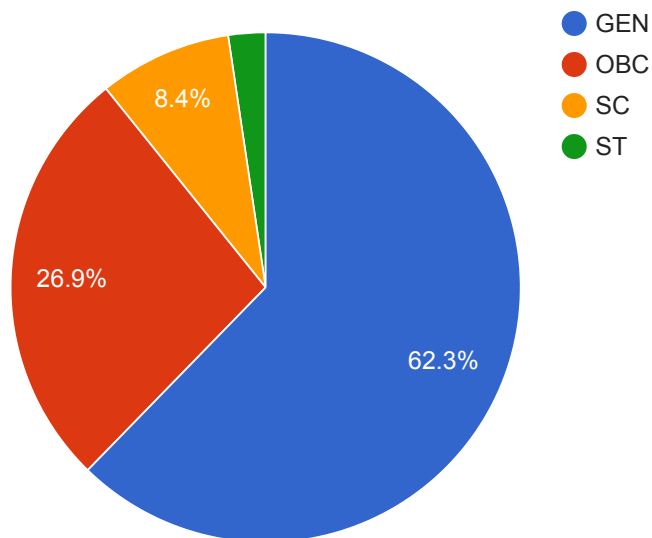

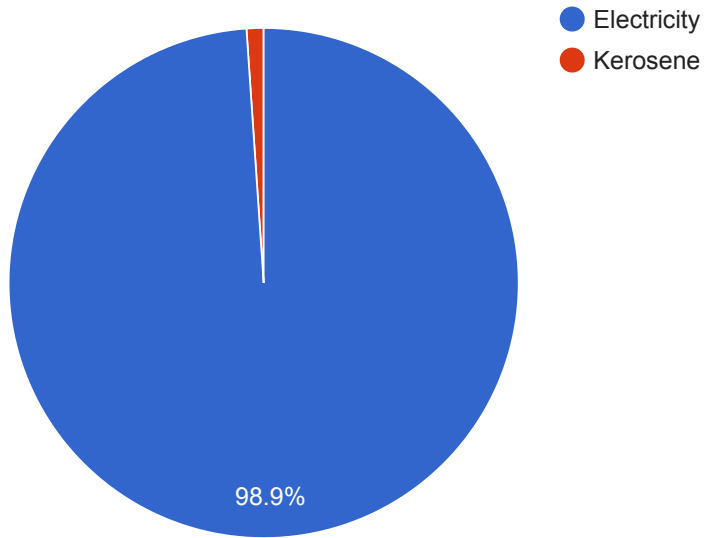

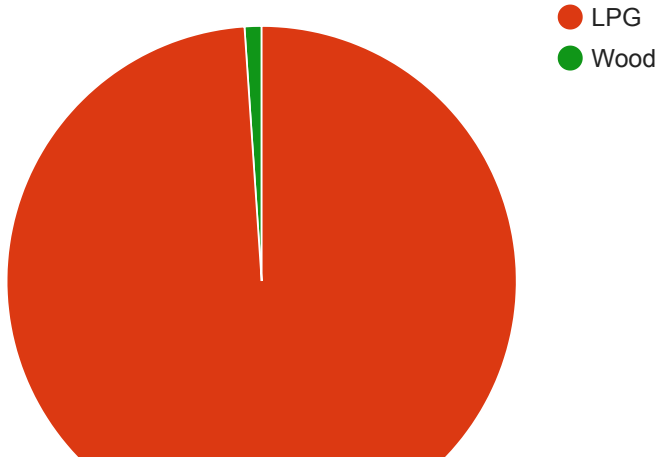
