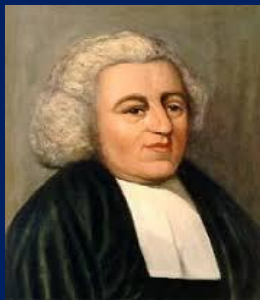


## SCIENTIST OF THE MONTH:



### Newton (1829-1907)

British Zoologist and ornithologist, one of the foremost in his time. In 1866, he was appointed the first professor of zoology and comparative Anatomy at Cambridge university. Despite the fact that he suffered from diseased hip joints and walked with the aid of two sticks, he traveled throughout Lapland, Iceland, the west Indies, and North America (1854-1863). During these he studied ornithology and became particularly in the great studies. He helped to prepare the first acts of parliament passed for the protection of birds. He wrote a great deal on his field of work, including a dictionary of birds, and the articles on ornithology in several 19<sup>th</sup> century.

Yet it is nevertheless true that he was one of the earliest naturalists in this country to accept Darwin's explanation of the origin of species. Not only did he receive with joy and admiration this momentous revolution in scientific thought, he actually made some effort to induce his brother naturalist to do likewise, but without success.
